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### UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE FUND COMPLIANCE CIRCULAR NO. 2/2022

### INTERIM SUSPENSION OF ISSUING AND REQUIREMENT FOR COMPLIANCE CERTIFICATE AS PROOF OF COMPLIANCE WITH THE UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE ACT 63 of 2001

The UIF has taken a firm stance that Compliance with the UIF legislation is non-negotiable for companies that are and/or intend to do business with Fund, and by extension to all Law Abiding Corporate Citizens in the Republic of South Africa, taking into account Government imperatives the country's Economy recovery initiatives.

These steps are now put in place to address the above:

1. In the interest of service delivery, the UIF from the date of signature of this **Circular NO. 2/2022**, hereby waive as an interim measure the requirement for Compliance Certificate as proof of compliance with UI legislation and as a condition for doing business with the Fund and/or other Government Departments or State Agencies.
2. The UIF will always be at hand to assist tenderers and companies who so require to comply and/or ensure that their Service Providers comply with the UI legislative requirements.
3. The content of this circular is by no means an instruction to other users, but an advise to consider the same steps in dealing with service providers in their procurement processes.
4. Compliance with the UI legislation remain non-negotiable and employers who are found non-compliant with the Act will be processed through the Enforcement Mechanism of the Department.
5. This circular shall remain in place until withdrawn by the Unemployment Insurance Commissioner on notice.
6. This Compliance Circular No. 2/2022 replace Compliance Circular No. 01/2022 issued on 15 March 2022.
