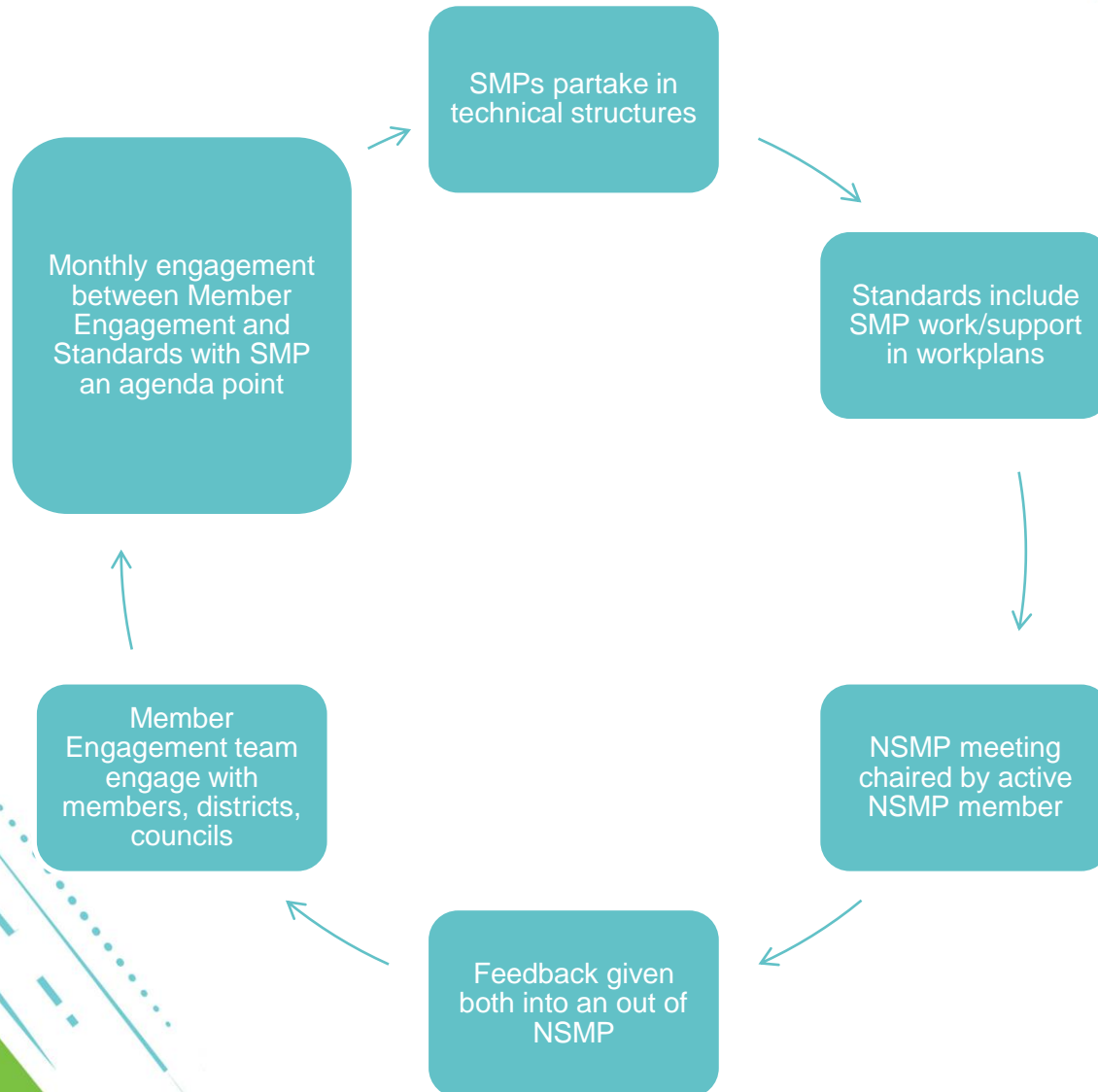

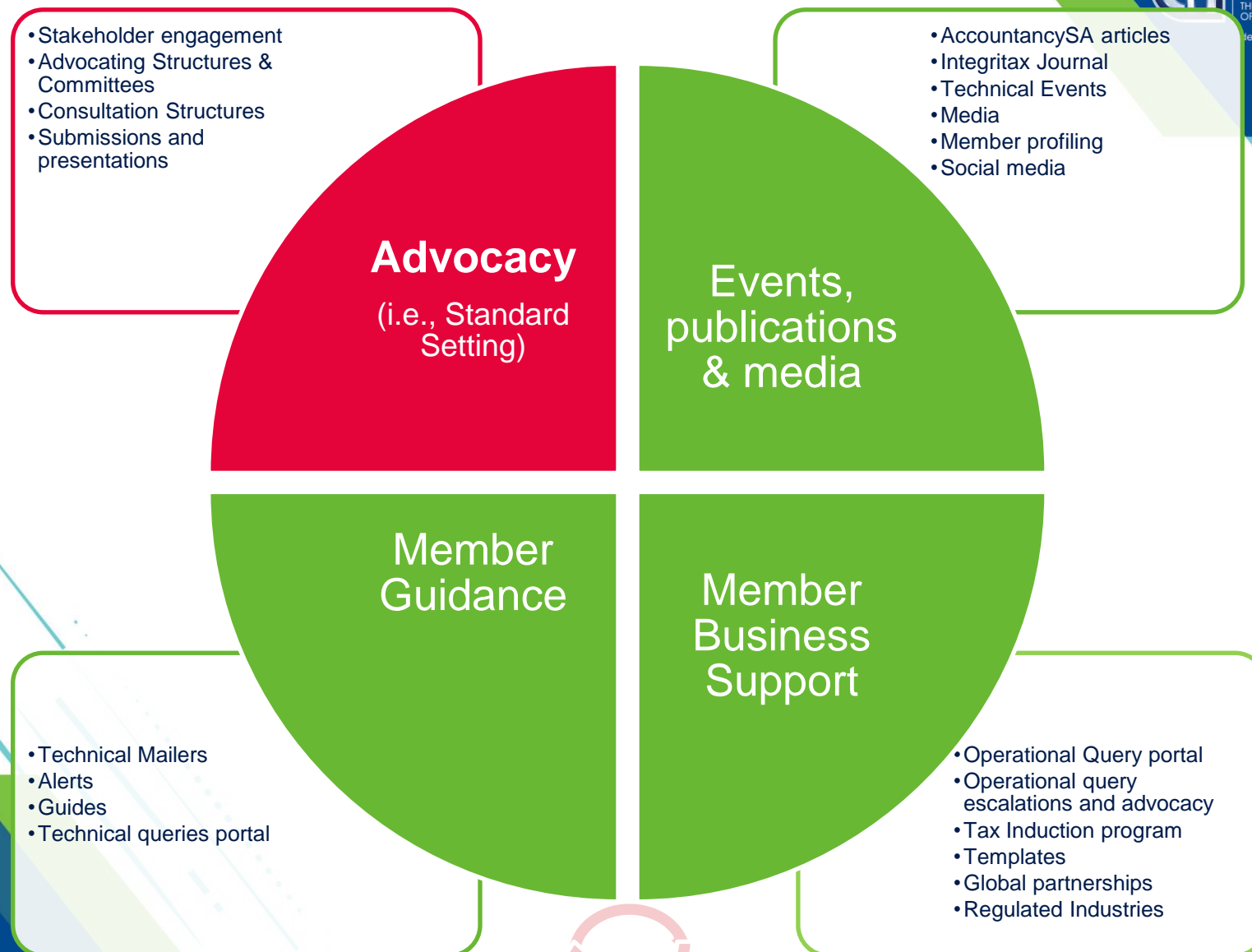

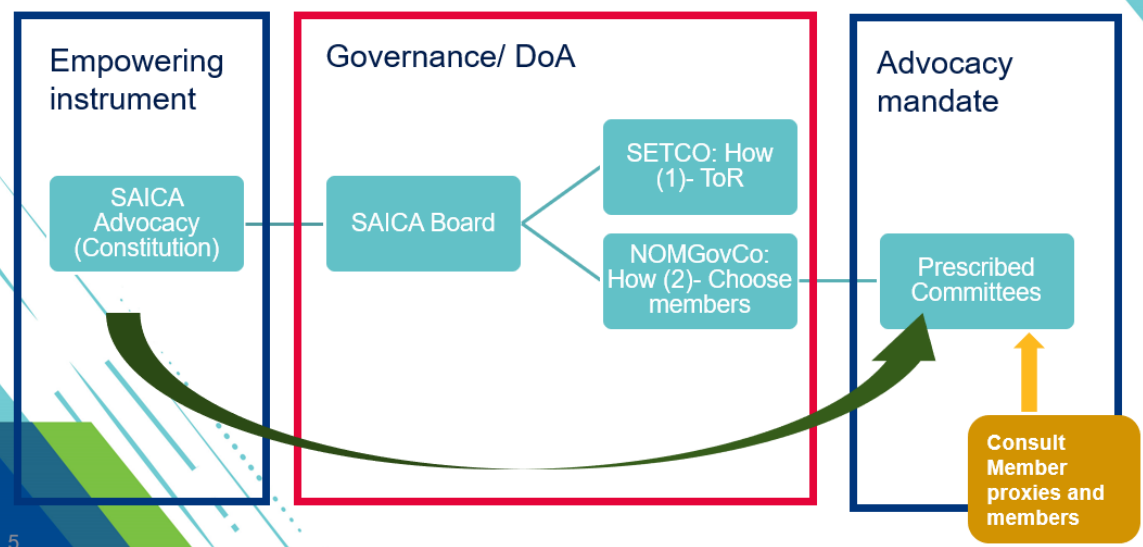

Nominations by SAICA Board - Person receives mandate and authority from SAICA Board and also direction as to how the person should receive membership proxy. Reports as directed by Board

Nominations by Advocacy groups: Person receives mandate and authority from SAICA Advocacy Group and also direction as to how the person should receive membership proxy. Reports as directed by Advocacy group

Management nominated
Role demands a SAICA person not a member
No advocacy group in that area or outside advocacy group technical mandate

Advocacy groups

Group has **primary mandate** and authority to advocate on behalf of SAICA or primarily advise to SAICA/Board under **authority of Board (Committees) but reporting to management**

Group has **secondary mandate** and authority (i.e. sub-delegated) to advocate on behalf of SAICA under **supervision of primary group (Sub-committees)**

Group **must** be engaged on technical positions to take under authority from **Board or Management**

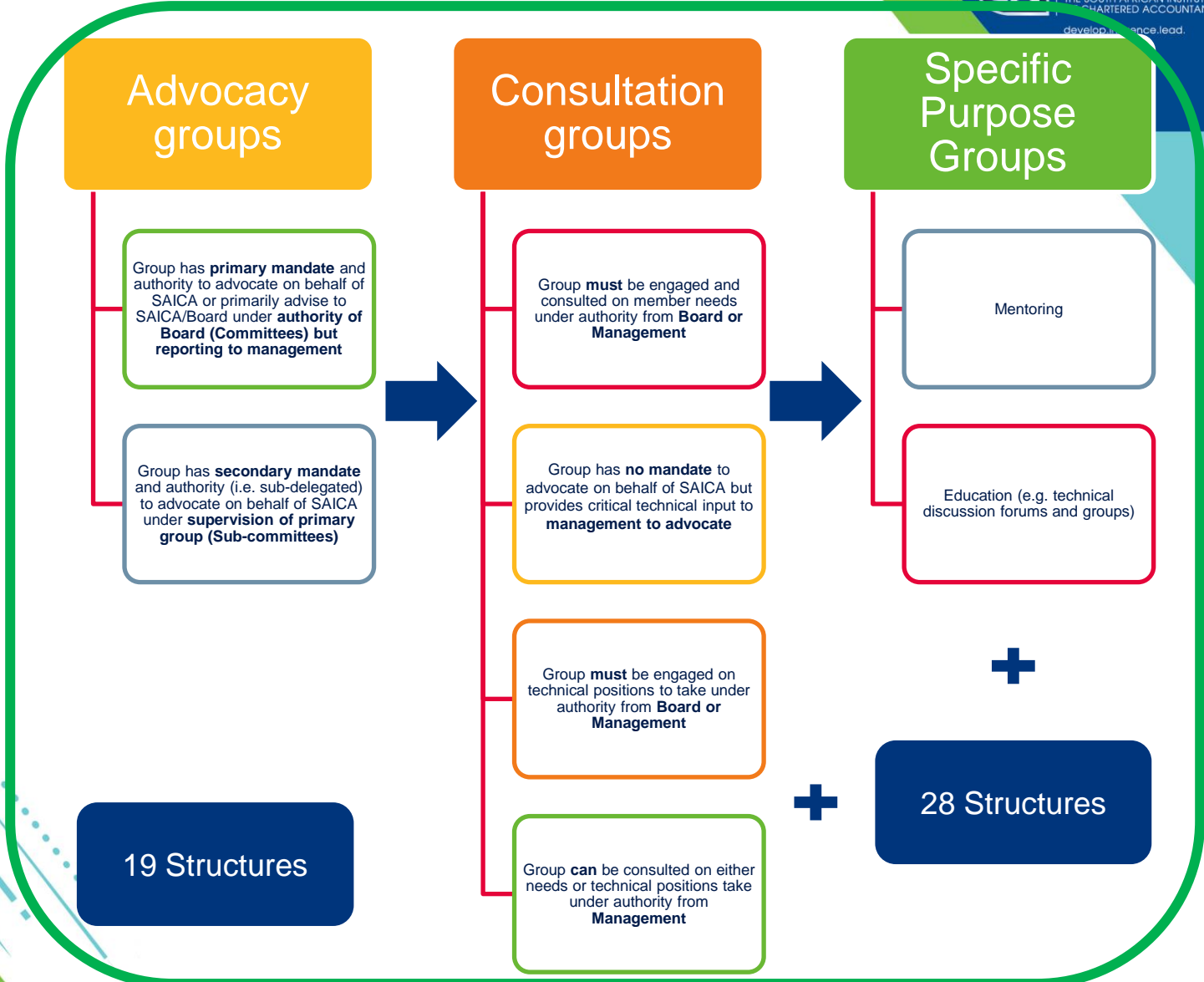
Group **can** be consulted on either needs or technical positions take under authority from **Management**

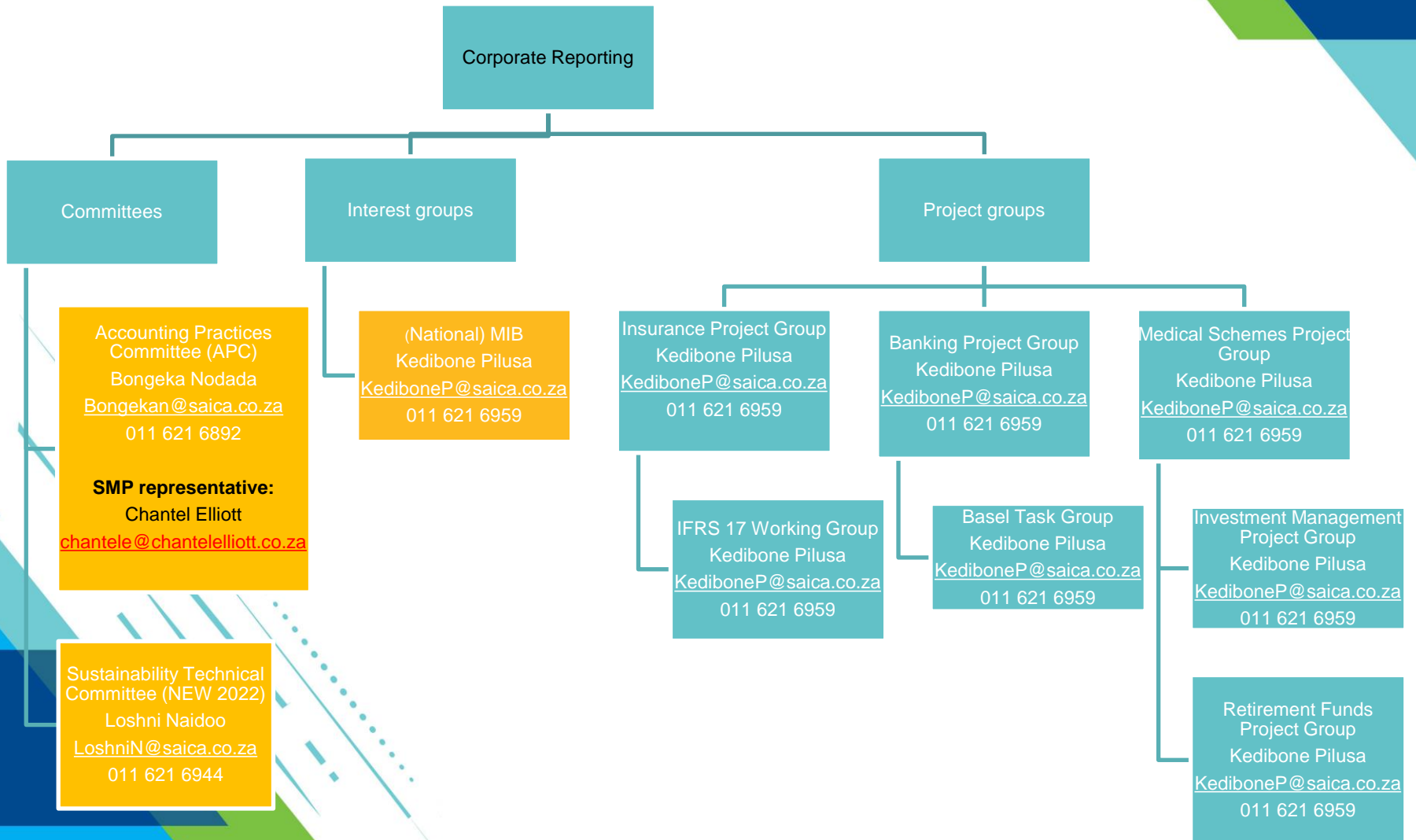
